



# Stationery Hanger



## SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

- POPTape™: Loud Lemon, Lagoon Blue, Double Denim, Chasing Rainbows and Lets Go Bananas.
- A3 Cardboard.
- Scissors/Craft Knife.
- Paper Punch.

## SKILL LEVEL: Advanced

### Step 1

Cover your cardboard both sides in Chasing Rainbows POPTape. You will need to place your tape across the 30cm width of the cardboard in horizontal rows. Take care to lay the tape directly beside the previous row and line up the Chasing Rainbows pattern as you go.

### Step 2

To make the large pocket, tear or cut 4 x 34cm strips of Double Denim. Lay the first one on your work surface sticky side up and attach the next strip by laying it beside

the first with a 5mm overlap to join them. Continue with the other 2 pieces until you have a rectangle of 4 rows of tape. Fold almost in half lengthways; you will need to leave a 2-3cm section of sticky tape exposed at one end. See image.

### Step 3

Add 2 more strips of Double Denim, one on each side of the rectangle so one end is level with the sticky tape at the bottom of the pocket and the other overlaps the top of the pocket by another 2-3cm. See image.

### Step 4

Attach the pocket to the covered cardboard as shown. The top folded edge of the pocket will need to line up with a join between 2 rows of the Chasing Rainbows tape.

### Step 5

To make the small pockets, cut or tear 2 x 20cm pieces of Lets Go Bananas and lay them side by side sticky side up. Cut another 16cm piece and lay it directly in the middle of the other 2 pieces. Cut out the section above this piece as per the

image. It should have a 2cm wide strip of sticky tape on 3 sides. Repeat to make the other 2 small pockets in Double Denim and Let's Go Bananas.




### Step 6

To trim the denim pocket, tear a 12cm piece of Loud Lemon POPTape and fold one end on the diagonal to create a triangle at one end. Attach the triangle to the front of the pocket and fold the rest of the tape to the back.

## Step 7

To trim the Lets Go Bananas pockets, tear a piece of Loud Lemon wide enough to go across the top of the pocket with a section to fold to the back. Attach to the top of the pocket.

## Step 8

To make the hang tabs, tear 4 x 15cm lengths of Lagoon Blue POPtape. Attach the first piece to the top of your stationery hanger 2cm in from the side and allow a 5cm overhang at the top. Turn the stationery hanger over and line up another piece from the back. Join them sticky sides together. Do the same with the other side. Trim the tops of the hang tabs to a point and use a hole punch to make the holes.

## Step 9

Attach your small pockets by lining up the Lets Go Bananas pockets to the outer edge of the stationery hanger. The top edge of the pocket with the Loud Lemon trim should line up underneath the first row of Chasing Rainbows tape. Add the Double Denim pocket directly in the centre. Make sure the top of this pocket also lines up with your first row of Chasing Rainbows tape. To secure the pockets, add an extra row of Chasing Rainbows tape directly above the pockets over the top of the first row, making sure you line up the pattern with the row below. Add another row of Chasing Rainbow tape between the small pockets and the large Double Denim pocket. This should also cover the original row of Chasing Rainbows tape.

## Step 10

To finish off the bottom edge, use a craft knife and starting 2cm up from the bottom right hand corner trim at an angle towards the centre as shown in the image. Repeat for the other side. You should have a section across the middle that is still straight across.

## Step 11

To finish your stationery hanger, trim the top and side edges with a 1cm border of Loud Lemon. Measure the length required for the sides and tear the tape lengthways down the centre so you have 2 long strips of tape. Attach to the front of the stationery hanger with a 1cm overlap, trim out the excess at the corners and fold the rest to the back. Repeat for the top and trim in front of the hang tabs. For the bottom edge you will need to use a full width of tape, trim at the corners and fold the excess to the back.
