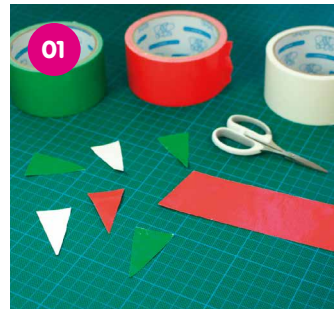




# Xmas Lantern



## SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

- POPtape™: Dynamite Red, Loud Lime and Polar White.
- White Paper Lantern (we used a 40cm lantern).
- Scissors.

## SKILL LEVEL: Advanced

### Step 1

To make your bunting flags, start by sticking your flag POPtape colours back to back in 30cm lengths to make double sided tape. Cut into evenly sized triangles, you will need approx. 80 flags in assorted colours to cover a 40cm lantern.

### Step 2

To make the bunting string, cut or tear a piece of Loud Lime POPtape, then cut or tear in half lengthways. Lay your tape sticky side up, place your triangles on the tape to the half-way point leaving 1.5cm between each triangle.

### Step 3

Once the triangles are in place, fold the top half of the bunting string over the top of the triangles to secure.

### Step 4

Repeat the above process to make the bunting as long as you need it to be to loop around your lantern 3-4 times. Join each section with a small strip of Loud Lime POPtape.

### Step 5

Attach the bunting to your lantern with small loops of POPtape sticky side facing out, place behind the flags at 10-15cm intervals.
