





Hanging Christmas Star



SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

- POPtape™: Loud Lemon, Loud Lime and Dynamite Red.
- Cardboard/Paper Card.
- Scissors/Craft Knife.

Step 1

Trace your star onto a piece of cardboard and cut it out. Ours is 18cm from point to point.

Step 2

Cover your star all over in Loud Lemon POPtape.

Step 3

To create the layers, you will need to cut or tear 50 pieces of Loud Lemon POPtape 5 x 5cm. Fold the top two corners down to create a point at the top.

Step 4

To add the folded layers to your star, work inwards from each point of the star, laying each of the pieces on the star and wrapping the overhang around the back of the star. Make sure you line up the points of each layer to the point of the star. Repeat until you reach the centre.

Step 5

As you get closer to the centre you will need to trim the sides of the folded layers to make them slightly smaller.

Step 6

Trace a 5cm star onto double-sided Dynamite Red POPtape, cut it out and attach to the centre of the star.

Step 7

To tidy up the back of the star, add another layer of Loud Lemon to cover the edges of the layers you have folded from the front.

Step 8

To hang your star make a chain from 6 x 15cm lengths of Loud Lime, fold each in half lengthways. Make a ring with the first one by attaching both ends with tape. Do the same with the remaining five, but link them together to make a chain.

Step 9

Attach the chain to the back of the star with Loud Lemon POPtape.
