






## Mini Christmas Tree



### SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

- POPTape™: Loud Lime.
- Scissors/Craft Knife.
- Paper Card – or a cone shaped party hat.
- Scrapbooking Christmas Stickers.

### SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

#### Step 1

To create the basic cone shape, draw your template as shown in the image. This will make a tree about 22cm high. Alternatively you can make a smaller tree and use an old party hat as your base.

#### Step 2

Cut out the template and form it into a cone shape. Join at the back with a piece of Loud Lime POPTape. If required, trim the base to make it level.

#### Step 3

Cover the paper cone completely in Loud Lime POPTape, enclose the top so it forms a point.

#### Step 4

To create the layers, you will need to work from the bottom of the tree through to the top. Measure around the base of the tree and cut or tear a piece of Loud Lime POPTape long enough to fit all the way around the base with a 1cm overlap. Lay your tape sticky side up on your

work surface and fold the bottom third over to join the sticky sides together. You should have one third of the tape with the sticky side still showing. Cut small slits every 0.5cm all the way to the sticky section along the top.

#### Step 5

Working from the base of the tree, stick the first layer all the way around overlapping the ends slightly to cover the join. Measure and cut the next layer as per the instructions in Step 4.

Position the next layer above the first layer so it overlaps and completely covers the uncut section of the previous layer. Continue all the way to the top of the tree. Decorate your tree with scrapbooking stickers.

Note: If you don't have scrapbooking stickers to finish your tree, cover a cardboard star shape with Loud Lemon POPTape and attach it to the top of your tree.
