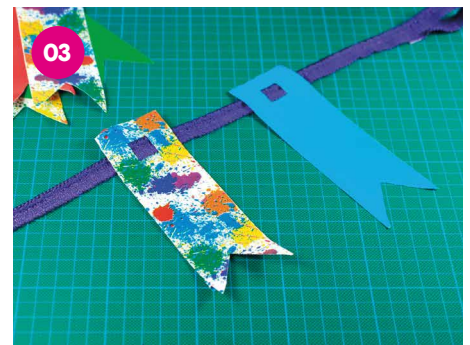
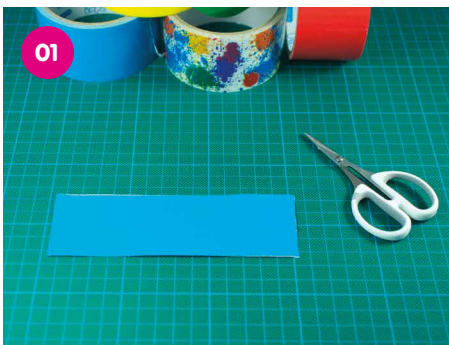




Pennant Party Bunting



SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

- POPtape™: Paint Splats, Lagoon Blue, Loud Lime, Loud Lemon, and Dynamite Red.
- Scissors/Craft Knife.
- Ribbon/Twine - 1.5cm wide x the length you require the bunting to be.

Step 1

To create the pennants, cut or tear 15cm lengths of each of your POPtape colours, and join them sticky sides together to create double sided tape. For a 3 metre length of bunting, you will need at least 30 pennants in assorted colours.

Step 2

To finish the pennants, measure 3cm from the bottom of the strip and cut a 3 cm 'V' into the bottom of each strip. Measure 1.5cm down from the top of each strip and then either side of the centre cut 2 x 1.5cm long slits. This is where you will thread your ribbon/tape through.

Step 3

Thread your ribbon through the 1.5cm slit and then across and through the second slit. Make sure that you thread all the pennants the same way so the ribbon is across the back of each pennant.
