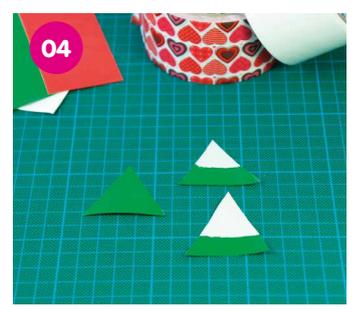




# Xmas Gift Tags



## SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

## SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

- POPTape™: Sweethearts, Dynamite Red, Loud Lime, Polar White.
- Non-stick Scissors & Craft Knife.
- Hole Punch.

### Step 1

To make the tag, cut or tear 2x13 cm lengths of POPTape in each tag colour. Join the 2 pieces sticky sides together to make a double sided piece of POPTape fabric. Trim the ends to tidy them up.

### Step 2

Cut a peak in the top end of each fabric strip and use a hole punch to create the hole for the ties.

### Step 3

To make the Sweethearts Christmas tree (you can cut any shape you like), tear a 7cm piece of Sweethearts POPTape and lay sticky side down on your cutting surface. Trace or draw a 5cm tree onto the tape, use a craft knife to cut around the outline. Peel off the tree shape and stick to your gift tag.

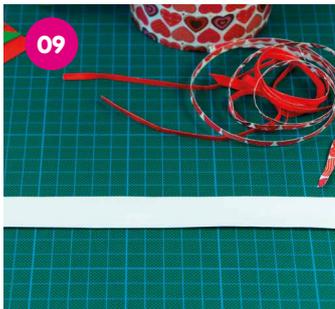
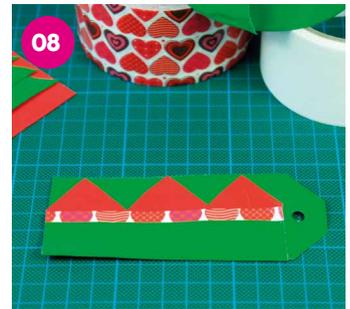
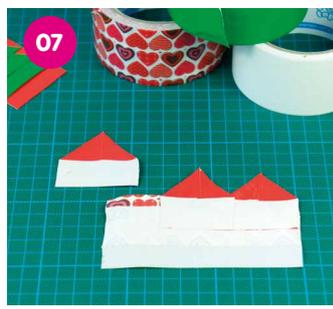
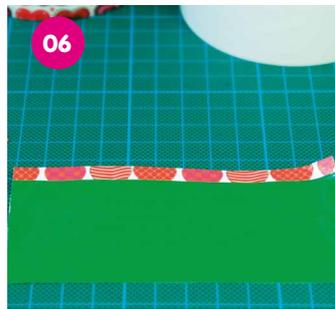
To make the green tree for the red gift tag, cut or tear 3x6 cm sections of green tape. Fold up 1.5cm at the bottom of the section of tape then using a craft knife cut away the sides to create a triangle.

## Step 5

Stick the triangles to your red gift tag starting 1cm up from the bottom of the tag and laying the 3 triangles starting from the bottom and overlapping each triangle as you go up. Cut a heart from a piece of Sweethearts POPtape to decorate the top of the tree.

## Step 6

To decorate the green tag, cut or tear an 11cm piece of Loud Lime POPtape. Lay sticky side up on your work surface. Lay an 11cm piece of Sweethearts tape along the top of the green tape with a 2cm overlap above the green. Fold down 1cm of the Sweethearts tape to create a neat folded edge at the top. You should have 1cm of the Sweethearts tape showing above the top edge of the green tape.

## Step 7

Tear 3x4.5 cm lengths of Dynamite Red POPtape. Fold down the top corners to create a triangle at the top and leave 1.5cm of sticky exposed. Lay the triangles with a slight overlap along the top edge of the section you created in Step 6.

## Step 8

Before you stick your decorative layer to the green tag, measure the length and trim the ends if required. Lay the decorative layer with the triangles lining up with the outer edge. Fold the rest of the green tape over to the back of the gift tag.

## Step 9

To make the ties for the gift tags, tear a 25cm length of tape in the colour you want to use and fold it in half lengthways. Cut this into 4 long narrow strips with non-stick scissors or lay on your cutting surface and use your craft knife.

## Step 10

To attach the ties, thread 2 ties in different colours through the hole in the top of your tag. Secure close to the top of the tag with a small 5mm wide strip of tape.
