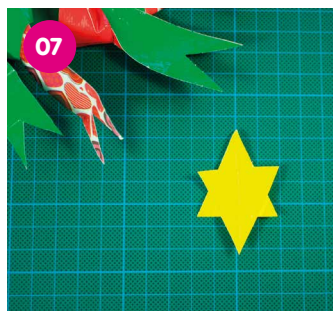
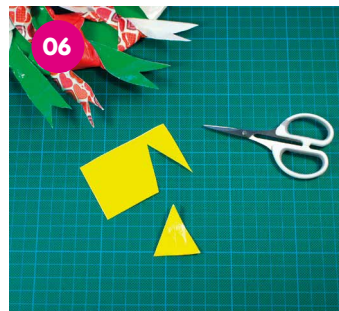
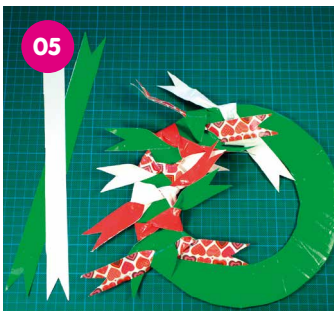
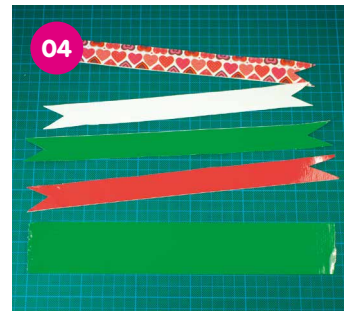
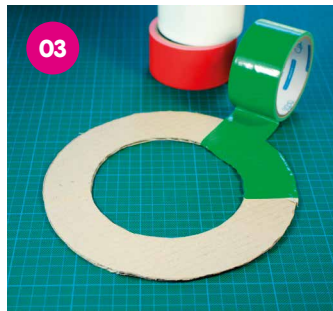
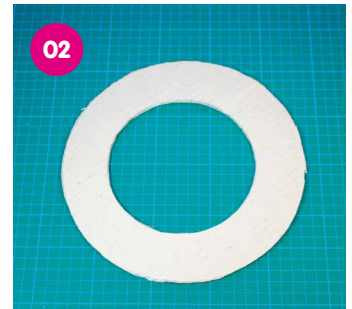
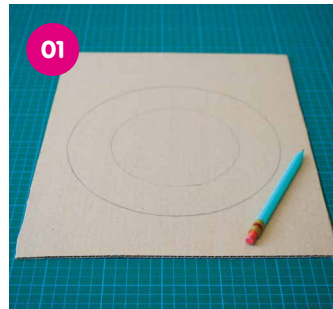




# Xmas Wreath



## SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

## SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

- POPTape™: Sweethearts, Dynamite Red, Loud Lime, Polar White, Loud Lemon.
- Cardboard or Paper Card.
- Scissors.
- Pencil.

### Step 1

Trace 2 circles onto your cardboard to the size you want your wreath to be. We used 22cm for outer circle & 13.5cm for inner circle.

### Step 2

Cut the cardboard to create the wreath.

### Step 3

Cover the wreath with your base POPTape colour. Note: it is easier to use several smaller strips than one continuous piece.

### Step 4

To make the ties, create 8 double sided strips of POPTape 30cm long. Cut in half length ways and trim the ends by cutting a V

shape. We used contrasting colours on each strip.

### Step 5

Tie each strip in alternating colours with a single knot.

### Step 6

Make a rectangle of double sided POPTape in Loud Lemon and cut 2 triangles to make the star.

### Step 7

Create 2 small loops of POPTape with the sticky side out and use one to join the 2 triangles to make the star. Use the other loop to attach the star to your wreath.
