



## Transformers Book Cover



### SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

- POPTape™: Black As Night, Loud Lemon, Lagoon Blue.
- Non-stick Scissors/Craft Knife.
- Reusable slip on book cover.
- Baking Paper.
- Marker Pen.
- Stencil or bold image for tracing.

### SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

#### Step 1

Cut a piece of baking paper large enough to fit your transformer stencil image and completely cover one side of the baking paper with Black As Night POPTape. Lay the paper on your cutting mat and trim the edges with the craft knife.

#### Step 2

Turn your baking paper over and trace your transformer image outline on the other side.

#### Step 3

To cover your book cover, start in the inside flap of your book cover and keep the tape on the roll and gradually release and secure small sections of tape at a time. Work your way from the inside flap over to the front, across the cover and finish off on the back inside flap of the cover. Continue until the book cover is completely covered in POPTape. Fold in and trim the edges as required.

#### Step 4

Cut out the transformer stencil using a fine tipped pair of scissors or lay it flat on your work surface and cut out each section with a craft knife. Position the image on the book cover. Gradually remove the baking paper off the back of each section of the image and stick down on your book cover until the image is complete. If you get any pieces in the wrong position, peel them off carefully and re-stick them.

#### NOTE

You can use both the inside pieces and the outside of the stencil to create 2 separate images and create 2 book covers.
