



Button Hearts



SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

- POPTape™: Pinkalicious Pink, Magical Unicorns, Polar White, Wild About Watermelon.
- Non-stick Scissors/Craft Knife.

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

Step 1

To make the hearts, cut or tear a 20cm length of POPTape in the colours you want to use. Fold the tape in half sticky sides together to make a 10cm piece of POPTape fabric. Trace on your heart shapes and cut them out.

sticky side down on your work surface. Using a craft knife, cut the tape lengthways into 3 pieces. On two of the pieces fold over one side not quite in half so you leave a 2mm sticky edge. Keep the remaining piece for the next step.

Step 2

To make a ruffle for some of the hearts, cut or tear 10cm of POPTape in the colour you want your ruffle to be. Lay it

Step 3

To create the ruffles, make small folds all the way along, sticking it as you go. Do this on both of the folded pieces from Step 2. Cut the leftover

piece from Step 2 in half so you have a narrow 10cm strip. Lay both your ruffles in the centre of one strip side by side.

Step 4

Attach the ruffles to the front of your heart and fold the ends over to the back to secure it down. Trim the bottom edges so they line up with the shape of your heart.

Step 5

Measure the size hole you will need to go over your buttons and cut small slits in the centre of each heart with a craft knife.

Step 6

Slip a button heart over each button on your shirt. You can make them all the same or mix up the colours and designs to make them all a bit different.

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
