




Captain America Shield



SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

SKILL LEVEL: Advanced

- POPTape™: Dynamite Red, Polar White, Chocolate Brown, Double Denim.
- Non-stick Scissors/Craft Knife.
- 52cm square cardboard or foam board (makes a 50cm shield).
- Baking Paper.
- Star & circle stencils.

Step 1

Draw or trace a 50cm diameter circle on your cardboard and cut it out. Completely cover the front side of the cardboard with Dynamite Red POPTape. Make sure each strip of tape has an overlap over the previous strip and the tape goes over the outside edge.

Step 2

Turn your shield over and secure down all the ends of the tape. It is easier to do this in small sections. Use

your craft knife to cut small slits in the overhanging tape all the way around. Fold the tape in small sections and secure firmly.

Step 3

Trace or draw an 18cm diameter circle on a piece of baking paper and cover the other side completely with strips of Double Denim POPTape. Make sure each strip of tape has a slight overlap over the previous strip so there are no gaps between the sections of tape.

Step 4

Cut out the denim circle. Find the centre point on the front of your shield by using a ruler to measure the distance from the outside edge. Peel the baking paper off the back of the circle and lay your blue denim circle in the centre of the shield. Press down firmly.

Step 5

Trace or draw a 16cm star on a piece of baking paper. The star should fit inside the

Double Denim circle with the points of the star reaching to the outer edges of the circle. Cover the other side of the baking paper completely with Polar White POPTape. Make sure each strip has an overlap so there are no gaps.

Step 6


Cut out the star, peel off the baking paper and lay the star in the centre of the circle. Press down firmly.



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Step 7

For the white circle use a ruler to measure and mark the midway point between the outer edge of the shield and the outer edge of the blue circle. Use a marker pen to mark points at 1/3 & 2/3 intervals. The points should be approx. 6cm apart. Mark points all the way around the circle using this method. The points need to be visible enough and close together enough to trace the outline of the white circle.

Step 8

Use a piece of baking paper and trace a section of the white circle. Cover the other side of the baking paper completely in Polar White POPtape.

Step 9

Cut out the section of circle, peel off the paper, and then line it up with the points you have marked on the shield before sticking it down. Trace the next section of the circle on a new piece of baking paper and proceed with the steps as above. Make sure the new section

overlaps the one before it so there are no gaps in the white tape. Continue until your white circle is complete. If you have any gaps cut or tear a piece of white tape to cover the gap.

Step 10

To make the handles for the back of the shield, cut or tear 4 x 25cm strips of Chocolate Brown POPtape. Join 2 pieces sticky sides together to create a double sided piece of brown tape. Do the same with the other 2 pieces.

Step 11

Turn the shield over to the back and using strips of Dynamite Red POPtape, stick the handles to the shield approximately 5cm apart.

Step 12

To finish your shield, completely cover the back of the shield in Dynamite Red POPtape. Trim the edges with a craft knife if required.
