




Double Denim Belt



SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

- POPTape™: Double Denim, Sweethearts, Dynamite Red, Polar White.
- 3.5-4cm button.
- 1 x pipe cleaner.
- Non-stick Scissors/Craft Knife..

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

Step 1

Measure the length of POPTape you need to go around your waist. Add an extra 10cm to allow for the overlap at the button. Cut or tear a length of Double Denim POPTape in the length required and lay it sticky side up on your work surface.

Step 2

Cut or tear another strip of Double Denim POPTape the same length, line it up with the edges of the first piece and lay it down sticky sides together to make a double sided denim strip. Trim the

ends and sides with your craft knife if required.

Step 3

Cut or tear a strip of Polar White POPTape the full length of your belt and lay it sticky side down on your work surface. Measure a 3cm wide strip and cut the tape lengthways. Lay the 3cm white strip directly down the centre of your belt.

Step 4

Cut or tear a strip of Dynamite Red POPTape the full length of your belt and

lay it sticky side down on your work surface. Measure a 2.5cm wide strip and cut the tape lengthways. Lay the 2.5cm Dynamite Red tape along your belt so the bottom edge of the red tape goes right to the edge of the Polar White tape.

Step 5

Cut or tear a strip of Sweethearts POPTape the full length of your belt and lay it sticky side down on your work surface. Cut out a full row of hearts lengthways. Lay the strip of hearts on top of the red tape

directly down the centre of your belt. You should have a small strip of red showing above the row of hearts and a wider strip of red showing below.

Step 6

To cut the button hole, measure the size of your button and cut a slit in the belt just long enough for the button to fit through. NOTE: Make sure you cut the slit horizontally in the centre of the belt. Start cutting at least 2.5cm from the end of the belt.





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Step 7

To add the button, lay your button on the tape, and using a pen mark where you will need to make the holes. Use a sharp skewer or pointed scissors to make holes through the belt, be careful to keep the holes separate from each other. Lay the button back on the belt and thread the ends of the pipe cleaner through two of the holes from the back to the front.

Step 8

To finish the button, thread the ends of the pipe cleaner back through the other two holes in the button to the back of the belt. Twist them around a few times to tighten, and then lay the ends flat along the belt.

Step 9

Tear a piece of Double Denim POPtape long enough to cover the ends of the pipe cleaner in order to secure it and cover any sharp ends.

Step 10

Cut a 4cm piece of Double Denim POPtape to trim the ends of the belt and cover any untidy edges.
