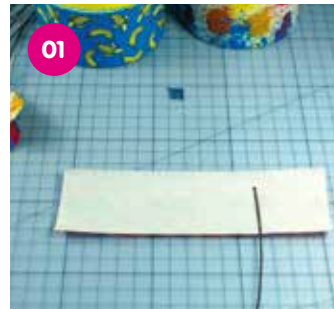




# Heart Bouquet



## SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

- POPTape™: Any colour/pattern.
- Non-stick Scissors/Craft Knife.
- 20 pieces of brown florist wire.

## SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

### Step 1

To make the hearts, cut or tear a 15cm length of POPTape in the colour you want to use. Lay the tape sticky side up on your work surface and lay the florist wire on one side of the tape half way between the midway point and the end of the tape. Make sure you lay the florist wire at least 1cm down from the top edge.

### Step 2

Fold the tape in half sticky sides together.

### Step 3

To cut a symmetrical heart shape, fold the tape in half again so the florist wire is along one side, you will be cutting half a heart then opening the sides out for the full heart shape. Start cutting from the top of the florist wire in a curve from the top of the heart and continue to cut out and around to where the bottom of the heart meets the florist wire.

### Step 4

Open out both sides and flatten. Trim the base of the heart to a point if required.

Note: You can do these in any symmetrical shape you like, try butterflies or circles and mix them all together.
