







Indian Headdress



SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

- POPTape™: Zany Zebra, Polar White, Plummy Plum Purple.
- Non-stick Scissors/Craft Knife.
- 7 feathers, assorted sizes from 8-15cm.

Step 1

Measure the size of your head and add an extra 4cm to allow for the join. Cut or tear a strip of Zany Zebra POPTape the length of your head measurement and lay it sticky side up on your work surface.

Step 2

Lay your feathers onto the tape so the bottom of the feather comes halfway down the tape. Working with the tallest feather directly in the centre and the

others at 4cm intervals either side, work from longest to shortest.

Step 3

Fold up the bottom half of the Zebra tape to secure the feathers inside.

Step 4

Cut or tear a strip of Polar White POPTape the same length as the Zany Zebra. Lay it flat on your work surface and use a craft knife & ruler to cut it down the centre lengthways.

Lay one half of the white tape over the Zebra tape leaving 1cm of the Zebra tape exposed at the top fold the remaining white tape to the back.

Step 5

Cut or tear a piece of Plummy Plum Purple POPTape the same length and lay it on the headdress just below the top edge of the white tape, leave about 4mm of white exposed.

Step 6

Turn over the headdress and fold the rest of the purple tape to the back leaving some of the white tape exposed at the back as well.

Step 7

Make the headdress into a circle and join the ends together with a 10cm strip of purple tape. Decorate the join at the back with small diamond shaped pieces of Zany Zebra POPTape.

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
