



Totally Wild Tablet Cover



SUPPLIES AND TOOLS:

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

- POPtape™: Black As Night, Spotty Leopard, Zany Zebra.
- Non-stick Scissors/Craft Knife.
- 2mm Packing Foam/Foam Wrap.
- Velcro Hook & Loop Adhesive Spots.

Step 1

Measure and cut your packing foam to cover your tablet. You will need to measure the foam to be 4 x tablet width + 4cm, 1 x tablet length + 4cm (4 x the width will allow double thickness on the foam for extra padding).

Step 2

To make the tab for opening and closing your cover, cut a 20cm length of both Spotty Leopard and Zany Zebra POPtape. Join the 2 pieces sticky sides together so you have a double-sided strip of POPtape.

Step 3

Decorate each side of the tab by placing a 1cm strip of tape in the opposite pattern down the centre. Trim a curve at one end.

Step 4

Fold the foam exactly in half and cover the top edge with a strip of Black As Night POPtape. Lay the tape with half at the front and fold the other half to the back. To secure the tab, lay it halfway between the middle of your foam and the outer edge, and then add your next layer of black tape to secure the tab under the tape.

Step 5

Continue to lay the black tape to completely cover both sides of the foam, go all the way to the outer edges of the foam and enclose the edges, place a strip of black tape around all of the outer edges with half the tape on the front side and the rest folded to the back. Trim the excess tape from the corners as required.

Step 6

On the opposite side of the cover to where you have attached the tab, lay a 1cm wide strip of Zany Zebra along the top edge. This will be the top inside edge of your tablet cover.

Step 7

Fold your tablet cover in half and secure the bottom edge and the side with a strip of black tape. Lay half the tape to the front and fold the other half to the back. The cover should now be completely enclosed except for the top edge where the open/close tab sits.

Step 8

Decorate your cover with strips of tape working from the centre to the outside. Measure the length of tape needed to run all the way from the top front around to the top at the back. The back of the cover should be a mirror image of the front. Cut or tear a strip of Spotty Leopard POPtape, place down the centre front and around to the back. Measure and cut a strip of Zany Zebra POPtape, lay the tape on your work surface and cut it down the centre lengthways into 2 long

narrow strips. Lay a strip of the Zebra tape on the cover, either side of the centre strip of the Leopard tape leaving a gap to expose some of the black tape in between. Finish the sides with a strip of Leopard tape laying half the tape to the front of the cover and folding the other half to the back. Trim the ends if required.

Step 9

Apply a Velcro hook & loop spots, one on the underside of the tab and the other to the front of the cover where the tab sits when closed.
